Representatives of the UDA completed the world's first Animal Detection Systems Management Course in Cambodia, receiving two of the seven ADS management certificates in the world.

For the first time in Ukraine, women are undergoing international IEDD training as part of the "She Demines" program.



A presentation of a manual on the employment of veterans in the field of mine action took place in Kyiv, the preparation of which was assisted by representatives of the UDA.



Representatives of the UDA participated in the GICHD workshop "Localization in Mine Action", where they shared their experience in developing a national operator and attracting international grants.
