UDA signed a direct agreement with the World Food Programme (WFP), becoming the first national operator to cooperate with WFP directly.



UDA signed an agreement with the Dutch government to provide 4 million euros for humanitarian demining – this is the first direct funding of a Ukrainian operator from the Netherlands.



Representatives of the UDA participated in the Mine Action 2026 symposium in Croatia, presenting Ukrainian experience in demining.



Representatives of the UDA participated in the ANZ Ukraine Forum 2026 in Warsaw and Lviv.
